INTRODUCTION

Why is logging off correctly important?

- · Correctly logging out of Pure Broking will significantly improve your experience.
- Logging out correctly will ensure that you are able to log back in efficiently.
- It will also remove the need for your license administrator to reset your connection

Note – during the day if you know you are not going to be using Pure Broking within the next hour, please follow these steps to log out correctly. This will support a more efficient experience when you next want to use Pure Broking.


LOGGING OUT OF PURE BROKING

STEP 1

Locate open Pure Broking windows and applications in your taskbar.

These can be identified by the green arrows in the top right-hand






Note – the following screen images are taken from a Windows system. MacOS users will experience a different look, but the process is the same.

STEP 2

Close the Pure Broking windows, apart from 'User Logon: Details', they should be closed in order from RIGHT to LEFT. Closure can be done by clicking the X in the top right-hand corner or selecting File > Exit depending on the window you are viewing.





STEP 3

Once all Pure Broking Windows are closed then click on the User Logon: Details icon.



STEP 4

Click 'Log Off', the 'User Logon: Details' window will close, and you will be logged out of Pure Broking.

Do not click the X icon of this window. Ensure that when you have finished and want to log out of Pure Broking that you click the 'Log Off' button.


